# Red Team Report Feedback Sessions

## facilitated by Steve Holland, DDICR

# Feedback Sessions (cont.)

## General principles gleaned from the sessions:

- Concerns about patient safety and quality of care raised in the Red Team report do not reflect lack of dedication and caring for patients by staff in the CC
- Pharmacy/PDS deficiencies reflect failure of NIH to meet FDA regulations and require improvements in facilities, training, and procedures
- Complaints submitted via the improved CC Occurrence Reporting System (ORS) and new anonymous safety hotline require prompt action and feedback
- Authority and responsibility for patient care needs to be aligned through Hospital CEO rather than fragmented across ICs
- More information is needed from follow-on focus groups
